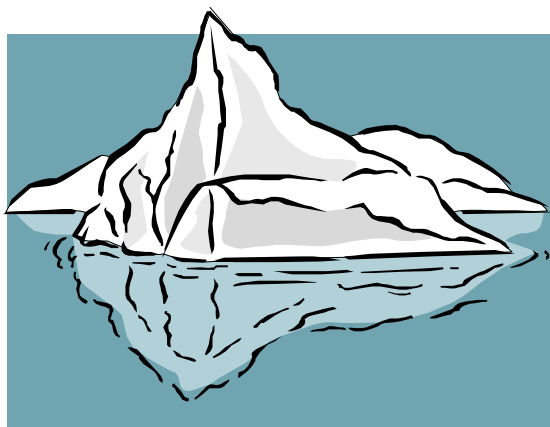


40 YEARS ON AN ICEBERG

Actions in brackets

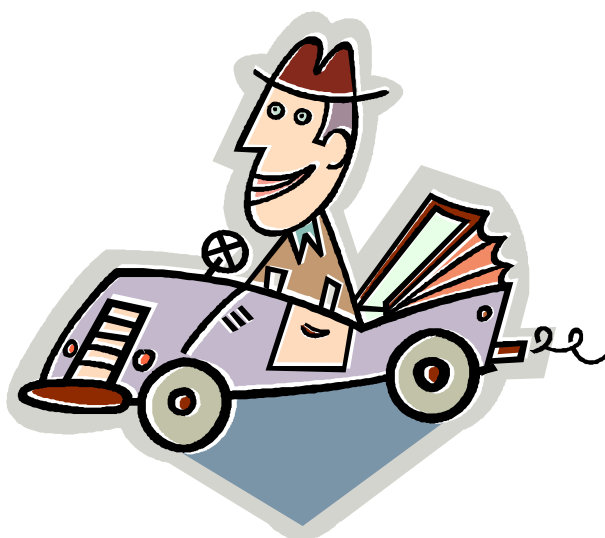
A FORD ESCORT

(use hand to whiz down a slope)

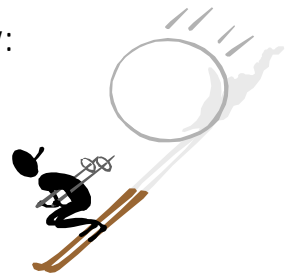
A mini, mini, mini

Yoo-I-ay-de, Yoo-I-ay-de, (ssh-ssh)



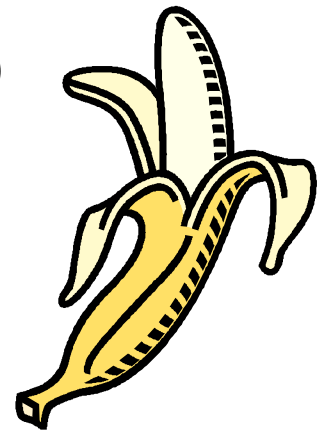
Avalanche (ssh-ssh)

IT'S A LION!!

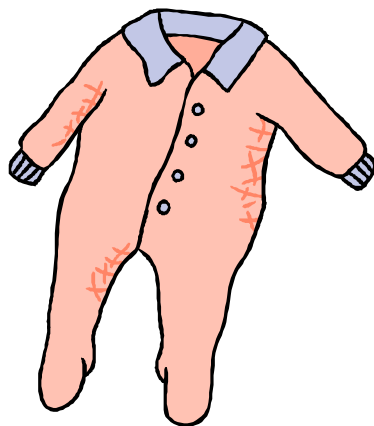


Leader sings one line, then group repeats, group slaps thighs as if marching

PINK PYJAMAS

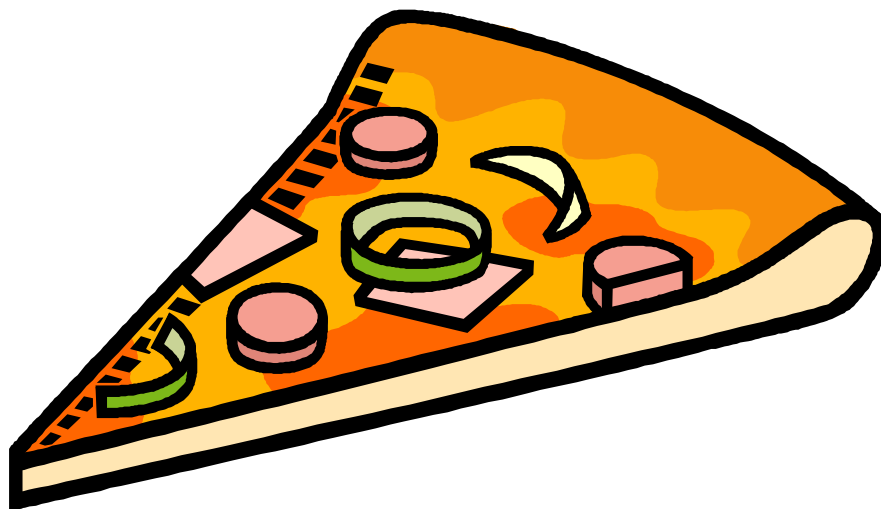
I wear my pink pyjamas in the summer when it's hot,

And trust my luck! *(repeat)*

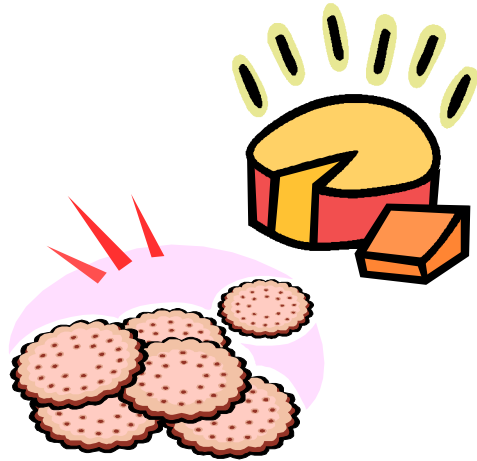
And so I jumped

Fish and Chips x6

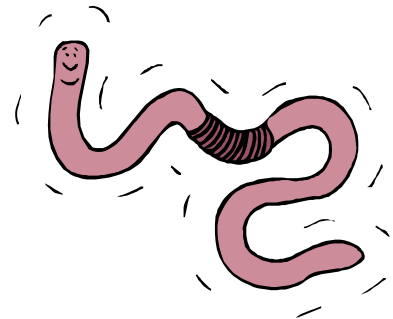

Start all sitting down and then stand up every time whoop is said.

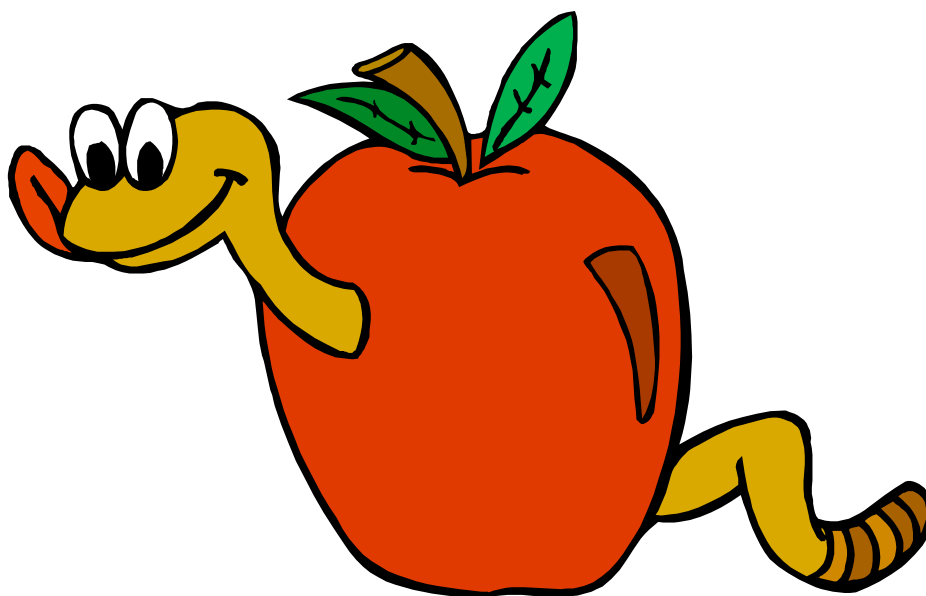
WORMS
