

Newspaper Jigsaws

Equipment: a sheet of newspaper and a dice per six

Preparation: put all sheets of newspaper together and cutting through all sheets together, cut several different shapes out of the sheets. (All sheets have identical shapes cut out of them.) Place all the cut out shapes in the centre of the room and one of each of the newspaper sheets with holes in them is given to each six.

Girls work in sixes. Each six has a dice and the girls take it in turns to throw. Anyone who throws a 6 runs to the centre of the room and selects a shape that they think fits their newspaper. The shape has to be the correct story – just having a matching shape is not enough. If the shape is wrong it goes back into the centre of the room and that is the end of their 'turn'. Game is over when one six completes correctly their newspaper.
