To Gain the Badge:-

Rainbows

Should complete 1 challenge from each section.

Brownies and Trefoil Guild

Should complete 2 challenges from each section.

Guides, Senior Section & Adults

should complete 3 challenges from each section.



## Choose from the following Challenges

### Section 1

#### The Twenty Five Section:-

1. Collect 25 postcards of places of interest. Do this as an individual, unit, patrol or six.
2. Save twenty five, 5p pieces each and give to a charity of the unit's choice.
3. Scavenger hunt- find something that starts with each letter of the word 'twenty five'.
4. How many words can you find in '**ChallengeTwentyFive**'.  
Have a competition to see who can find the most.
5. Either Skip 25 times, Hula Hoop for 25 rotations, do 25 Step-Ups or 25 Press-Ups.

### Section 2

#### Craft Section:-

1. Make a bracelet, necklace or phone charm using silver beads, paint, and fabric or use your own ideas.
2. Create the Brownie promise badge from the 1980's- use clay, block icing or marzipan to make your badge.
3. Make an animal out of tin foil.
4. Make a safety pin bead badge to say 25.
5. Produce a collage using silver materials.



## And from these Challenges

### Section 3

#### The Out of Doors

1. Using foil dishes & nightlights, cook mini pancakes or make a hot drink.
2. Create a miniature garden in a silver foil tray.
3. Find some silver birch bark and use it to light a fire on an old tin lid.
4. Boules were originally made of metal- play a game with your patrol, six or unit.
5. Challenge another unit to a game of continuous cricket.

### Section 4

#### Music Section

1. Listen to a small piece from 'Tubular Bells' and then create your own set of wind chimes.
2. Learn & sing 'Land of the Silver Birch' (Rainbows 1 verse, Brownies 2 verses).
3. Listen to a piece of music being played by a 'Silver Band'.
4. Have the girls who play the flute (or similar) share their talent at a meeting.
5. Invite a bell ringer to your unit meeting.

## And finally from these Challenges

### Section 5

#### Miscellaneous Activities-:

1. Hold a party with a silver or sparkly theme.
2. Clean a piece of silverware.
3. Lay a table using the correct cutlery.
4. Play Kim's Game with only silver items.
5. Make fairy cakes and decorate them in silver icing etc.
